City of Española, New Mexico: Resolution No. 2019-01, A Resolution requiring the prompt removal of ruined, damaged and dilapidated structures, materials, debris and abandoned vehicles to abate a menace to the public comfort, health, safety and welfare at the following locations: 506 E. Chamisa St., Apartments 1-4; 803 S. Riverside Dr.; 312 Carr Ln.; 750 N. Monterey Ln.; 1015 W. Bond St.; 1008 Calle Vigil; 901 Calle Quintana; 601 Old Hospital Rd.; 906 E. Pueblo St.; 718 & 800 A Fairview Ln.; 117 S. Coronado Ave, Apartments 1-6; 101 N. Riverside Dr.; 804 A & B State Rd. 76; 2227 A & B N. McCurdy Rd.; 1003 A & B Calle Lopez; 2119 A & B N. Riverside Dr.; 2004 N. McCurdy Rd., Española, NM 87532, In the City of Española, Santa Fe and/or Rio Arriba counties, New Mexico (the "properties"); requiring the owner or owners of the properties to promptly commence and complete the removal from the properties of all ruined, damaged and dilapidated structures, materials, debris and abandoned vehicles, including but not limited to structures, abandoned motor vehicles, manufactured or mobile residential/commercial structures, travel trailers, weeds, dead tree limbs, rubbish and other debris; provided that an owner, occupant or agent in charge of any individual property may file written objections to this resolution seeking a hearing before the governing body of the City of Española; authorizing the administration of the City of Española to cause removal of the ruined, damaged and dilapidated structures, materials, debris and abandoned vehicles if owners of an individual property do not timely undertake such removal and providing that the governing body of the City of Española ("City Council") authorizes the city administrator to take actions it deems necessary or convenient to lien the individual properties, pursue foreclosure of the property by any available legal remedy so as to recover its costs and expenses incurred in cleaning the property. – *Planning & Land Use Director Richard Hubler*
