A RESOLUTION APPROVING A BUDGET ADJUSTMENT REQUEST IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,000 INCREASING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES TO CREATE SAFER CROSSWALKS THROUGH THE ARTS PROJECT IN ESPAÑOLA, NEW MEXICO IN RIO ARRIBA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, The New Mexico Department of Health Comprehensive Cancer Program enlisted the support of The University of New Mexico's Prevention Research Center (PRC) VIVA Connects to allocate \$4,000 to fund a community project in line with The Community Guide's evidence-based strategies to encourage physical activity; and

WHEREAS, Safer Crosswalks Through the Arts has been selected as this project will modify the built environment by creating three artistically designed crosswalks in high need areas in town to increase safety for pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, this funding will support the City of Española and the Northern New Mexico Regional Art Center in purchasing paint, brushes, buckets, towels and coordinating with local artists and youth to complete this project; and

WHEREAS, the three artistically designed crosswalks will be created at these designated sites:

- a. In front of James H. Rodriguez Elementary School and connecting to the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Park
- b. Across Bond St. leading towards the Plaza de Española
- c. Between a YDI (Youth Development Inc.) Headstart Daycare Center and Valdez Park.
