RESOLUTION NO. 2022-14**

**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE EXISTENCE OF SEVERE,
EXTREME AND EXCEPTIONAL DROUGHT CONDITIONS IN
THE CITY OF ESPANOLA AND EXTENDING FOR AN
ADDITIONAL THIRTY (30) DAYS THE PROVISIONS OF
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-11 ON THE PROHIBITION ON
THE POSSESSION OR USE OF FIREWORKS IN THE
CITY OF ESPANOLA AND AUTHORIZING OFFICERS OF THE CITY TO
ENFORCE THE PROHIBITION ON SALE OR USE OF
FIREWORKS BY APPROPRIATE ACTION**

WHEREAS, the statutes of the State of New Mexico, NMSA (1978), Section 60-2C-8.1 provide that a municipality may impose restrictions upon the sale and use of fireworks if the municipality determines that extreme or severe drought conditions exist, and may extend such restrictions for so long as the said conditions exist; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2022-11 on April 28, 2022, determining that severe, extreme and exceptional drought conditions exist within the City and are likely to continue; and


WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that the conditions of severe, extreme and exceptional drought continue to exist with the City; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body wishes to renew and extend the restrictions and prohibitions contained in Resolution No. 2022-11 for an additional thirty (30) days;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the restrictions and prohibitions on the sale, use and possession of fireworks contained in Resolution No 2022-11 are hereby extended for a period of thirty (30) days, effective immediately and remaining in effect through July 14, 2022.
